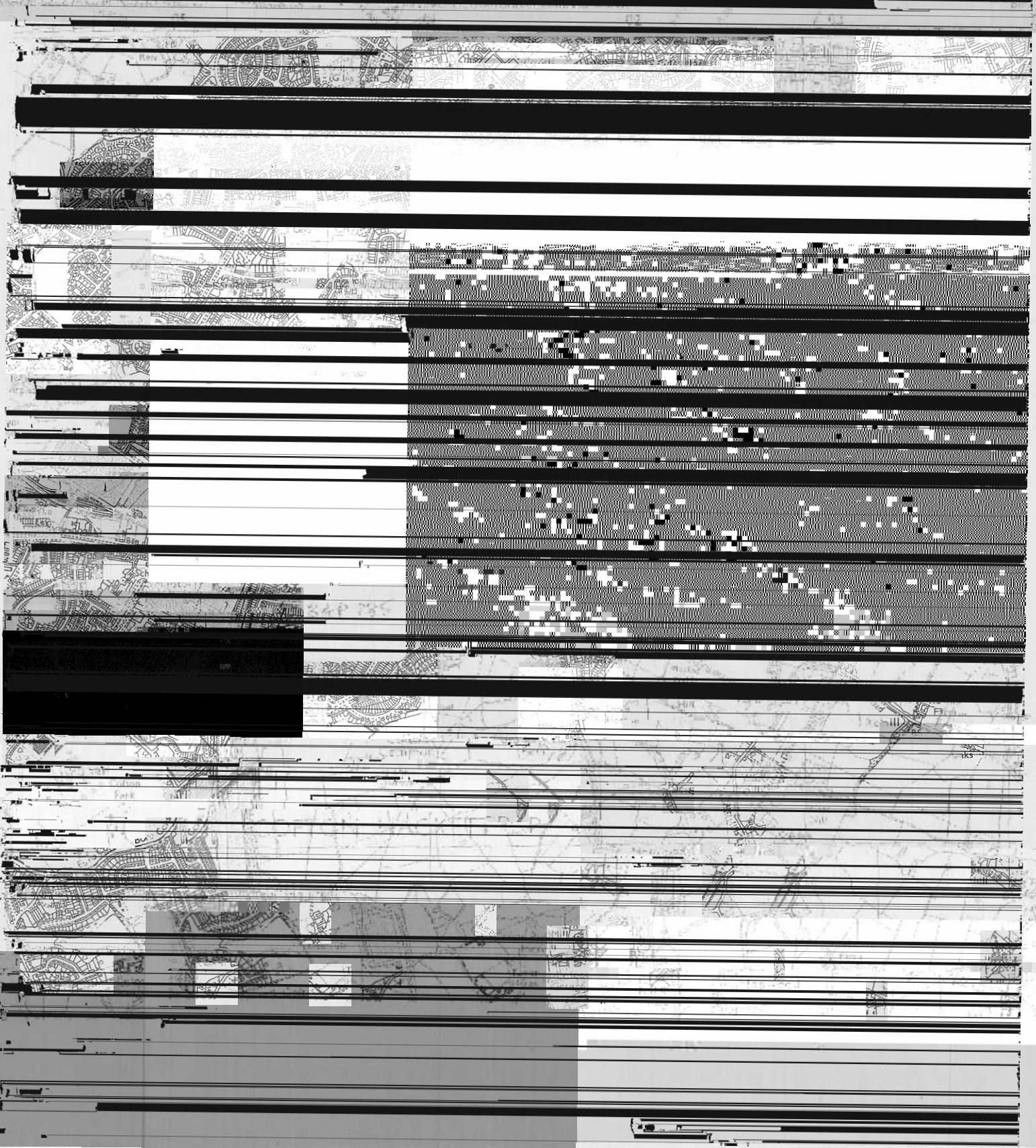

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 285

1 The south-west end of the original footpath is recorded on the map with the
 of 1840. (Held by the City Council in the
 County Record Office at Coventry.)
 on the first edition of the Ordnance
 Survey map of 1840, which showed the path as to be diverted
 from Grovetey Lane. The map
 in 4 parts, namely No. 3: Field,
 No. 4: Field ditch, garden and
 Footpath, etc. (Held by Warwickshire
